Keeping workers safe and informed

"The World Health Organization (WHO) has downgraded COVID-19, and it is no longer a public health emergency. As of June 30, 2023, Intel COVID-policies expired; and going forward the COVID-19 illness will be treated per Intel's existing health and absence policies, subject to local regulations.

Workers located in California should continue to report positive COVID-19 cases:

- All authorized supplier representatives shall promptly inform Intel of a confirmed COVID-19 case if it involves one of their employees or subcontractors who has been on an Intel California site or within close contact with any other worker during their Intel engagement in California. This account should only be used to report confirmed cases of workers who were present on an Intel campus/site in California. Suppliers may also need to comply with applicable government reporting requirements.
- When notifying Intel of a confirmed case, <u>use this link</u>, complete the fields, and submit. If you are resubmitting a previous notification, please identify this on the "case status" field. Information should not include: Name or other detailed personal information of the involved worker or other workers. Please ensure that the contact tracing is included in the report.
